Welcome to Peter Burke, previous Chaplain to AnglicareSA, who will make a presentation at our services today giving an update on Anglican Board of Mission in its 175th year.

If you wish to donate after this, there is a retiring offering for the mission work of ABM.

Jeremy Greaves, Archbishop of Brisbane, in a recent address celebrating the 175th anniversary of ABM said, "ABM has always embodied that conviction: that mission is not something we do to others, but something we share with others. [ABM's] work has never been simply about charity, but about relationship—mutual giving and receiving, being alongside sisters and brothers in their struggles and in their hopes."

Archbishop Jeremy ended his talk with a challenge to ABM and its supporters: "May we take courage from the past, draw strength from the faithfulness of those who have gone before us, and recommit ourselves to that same Christian optimism that "recognises no defeat." With God's help, and as a faithful Church, the work must—and will—go on."
