## IN OUR CHURCH

### *Christ is Risen, Alleluia!*

*If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. Then those also who have died in Christ have perished. If for this life only we have hoped in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. (St Paul, 1 Corinthians 15.17-20)*

The central importance of the resurrection is the meaning that it gives to the crucifixion of Jesus. Jesus claimed that he would give his life for us, that through his sacrifice we could know the guilt that we carry wiped out - that we could have new start with God. He promised that his death would defeat death – that final mocker of what it means to be human - and that those who put their faith in him would know what he called 'eternal life' - a life lived with God both now and beyond the grave. If the resurrection had not happened all these promises would have been empty, and truly faith in Jesus would be in vain. But if he has truly been raised from the dead then all the promises he made are true - and God in the person of Jesus Christ has stepped into our world and stands knocking at the door of our lives.

## **NEW COVID REGULATIONS FOR CHURCHES**

We have received new directions regarding churches, summarised as follows:

### **From Midnight, as we enter Good Friday 15<sup>th</sup> April**

- NO QR Codes are required
- NO Density limits
- Physical Distancing - No Requirement in churches and public activities - Strongly recommended where possible
- Masks – No Requirement in churches and public activities - Strongly recommended in crowded spaces.

NB: Individual choice must be supported for those who wish to maintain this practice.

- Singing – all restrictions eased, including choirs
  - Hospitality – all restrictions eased as long as good infection control is in place
- The mode of Holy Communion is still under discussion but in the future where people wish to use an individual glass, rather than the common cup, this is to be respected.
