Introducing our Locum: The Rev'd Dr Don Owers AM.

Don is currently the Ministry Development Advisor (MDA) for the Diocese of Adelaide and a member of the Archbishop's Pastoral Leadership Team. He has wide experience in pastoral ministry and academic management having previously been Principal of St Barnabas' College (SBC), Principal of Tabor College, Rector of St George's, Magill and Associate Minister at St Matthew's, Kensington.

Don will be working 2 days per week as MDA and adjunct lecturer at SBC, and two days a week with St Luke's. At present he is intending to be in the parish on Tuesday and Thursday mornings (and, of course, Sunday mornings) with other pastoral or administrative work taking up the balance.

Don and his wife Elizabeth have two 'grown and flown' children and three grandchildren. Elizabeth will be worshipping with us during the interregnum.
