The following items would be greatly appreciated.

**1. Food that does not require refrigeration, heating or cooking facilities**

Please look for ring pull cans.

Bowls and cutlery are useful too.

- Up&Go packs
- Small long life milks
- Breakfast biscuits or single serve packs
- Snacks like cheese and cracker packs, muesli bars, biscuits
- Tinned fish and meat, baked beans, spaghetti, vegetables Small tins please
- Fruit tubs

**2. Food for people who have access to cooking facilities**

- Full boxes of cereal
- 1ltr long life milk
- Instant noodles, 5 pack or cups
- Soups, packet or tinned
- Larger tins of fish, meat, spaghetti, baked beans and veg.
- Pasta, rice
- Pasta sauce, tinned tomatoes
- Canned fruit, or fresh
