Like Children: Receiving the Kingdom of God

(Luke 18:15–30)

In this Sunday's Gospel, two scenes unfold side by side — one tender, one troubling. First, people bring their babies to Jesus, hoping he'll bless them. The disciples try to send them away, thinking children are too small, too unimportant, to bother the teacher. But Jesus stops them with words that echo across the centuries:

"Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs."

Then, almost immediately, a wealthy ruler approaches Jesus with a serious question: "Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" He has kept all the commandments, lived an honourable life — yet Jesus tells him that one thing is missing. He must let go of what holds his heart captive. The man turns away, saddened, because his wealth gives him a sense of control that he cannot release.

Both stories are about how we enter the kingdom of God. Children enter it easily, with empty hands and open hearts. The rich ruler finds it almost impossible, not because wealth is evil, but because it tempts us to believe we don't need God.

Jesus invites us to become like children again — not childish, but childlike: aware of our dependence, unashamed of our need, ready to trust the One who provides.

In a world that prizes self-sufficiency and control, Jesus offers a different way: a life rooted in trust, generosity, and grace. The kingdom of God is not earned or achieved — it is received.

This Sunday, may we come before God with open hands, as children do, ready to receive the gift of life that only Christ can give.
