IN OUR CHURCH

Trinity Sunday

People today generally come to faith by a process of being drawn to Jesus in some way, discovering him as Saviour and Lord, and then discerning the character of the Father revealed through the Son (John 14.8 – 11). Finally, usually as their faith matures, they recognise also the preparatory and indwelling work of the Holy Spirit – who reveals Christ to us, convicts us of our need of salvation and indwells and directs our lives (Romans 1.1-4, John 16.12-16). In other words, most Christians *experience* God as Trinity before they ever try to understand or explain the *doctrine* of the Trinity. And I'm not sure you need to be able to explain it necessarily – we can be content with the faith that we have experienced – and many Christians are. In a way the doctrine of the Trinity is simply the distilled experience of the church that is written down and agreed upon. It's important, however, that this was done, because the doctrine of the Trinity is essential to ensure that, if threatened, key aspects of our faith can be explained and defended in words that have been carefully thought through and which have stood the test of time. We express the doctrine of the Trinity each week in the Nicene Creed, first formulated at Nicea in 325AD and ratified in Constantinople in 381AD.
