#### The Heart of the Matter

Matthew 15.1 - 20:

Today's gospel reading begins with Jesus in conflict with a group of Pharisees who, Matthew tells us, had journeyed from Jerusalem to Galilee to challenge Jesus about, of all things, the handwashing habits of his disciples. That's a four day hike to discuss handwashing!

The Pharisees were a loosely knit group held together by their zealous obedience to the commands of the Old Testament and the religious traditions that had developed from it. Not all Pharisees saw themselves as God's police, but it seems this delegation did.

By the time of Jesus, the traditions around handwashing had evolved from common-sense concerns about hygiene to quite complex rituals (Mark 7.3-4 describes them in more detail) some of which would have presented difficulties for ordinary working people, who might then find themselves condemned by the Pharisees on account of their apparent carelessness.

Then and now, Jesus challenges the self-appointed Church police who judge according to outward compliance with ritual. True faith, he tells them (then and now), is not about outward ritual but inward conversion of the heart.
