Memory, Thanksgiving, and Hope

Today we gather to celebrate one of the great festivals of the Christian year the Feast of All Saints. It is a day that holds both memory and promise: we look back with gratitude for all who have gone before us in the life of faith, and we look forward with hope to the glory that is promised to us all in Christ. On this day, we give thanks for the saints — the great and the small, the famous and the forgotten, those who are named in history and those whose holiness was known only to God.
