Across Australia, it is estimated that over 5 million (5.025 million) people volunteered through an organisation or group in 2020. This is almost one quarter (24.8%) of people aged 15 years and over. These volunteers gave 489.5 million hours of work to the community. At the current basic wage for adults this works out as equivalent to \$9.8 billion contributed to the wellbeing of others. And these figures relate only to 'formal' volunteering – that is volunteers who work through an organisation. If we were to add in the contributions of informal volunteers the numbers would be even more impressive. Today we acknowledge and thank these usually unsung heroes who contribute so much to our community in so many different ways!
