St Luke the Evangelist

Who was St Luke? The New Testament and tradition identify him as the author of the Gospel that bears his name (and also author of the book of Acts), and the sometime missionary companion of St Paul (Colossians 4.14; Philemon 24 and 1 Timothy 4.11). It's clear from the opening of his Gospel that Luke was not one of the original followers of Jesus, since he writes that he has undertaken to draw up an account of the life and teaching of Jesus based on 'what has been handed down to us by those who were eye-witnesses and servants of the word.' That said, Luke also tells his patron, Theophilus, that he has 'investigated carefully' and written 'an orderly account' so that others, like Theophilus (and us), 'may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.' Luke's purpose in writing his Gospel is thus to underpin, with a well-researched and clearly written account of the life of the Jesus, the faith of those who trust, or who are thinking of trusting, in Jesus.
