IN OUR CHURCH

Rev'd Don is conducting a Mission Planning process today for St Albans Church, Largs Bay.

The Rev'd Julie Worrall has kindly offered to step in and lead us through Holy Communion. Julie is the Director of Ministry Formation for the Diocese and St Luke's provides training and formation for newly ordained and aspiring clergy, so we have a shared interest in this important task and it's good to have this opportunity to meet Julie and for her to get to know a bit more about our parish.

Today Rev'd Cameron will bring us the second of our series of four sermons on St Paul's letter to the Colossians. Cameron will speak on Colossians 1.15 – 29.

The Lambeth Conference 2022 is a conference, held every ten years, to which all Bishops in the World-Wide Anglican Communion are invited. It's named for the London residence of the Archbishop of Canterbury in the (none too celebrated) London suburb of Lambeth. This year's conference will, however, be held in Canterbury with the Bishops and their spouses staying in the University of Kent. One day has been set aside for a retreat within Canterbury Cathedral. The actual dates for the conference run from July 27 to August 7. All the bishops from our Diocese will be attending the conference. New Bible Study series. As of the week starting 25th of July, St Luke's will be commencing a new bible study series titled The Bible Course: Exploring the Big Story. The study will run for one hour, starting with a short video of approximately half an hour and finishing up with a conversational study. The two options that we have available are either Monday morning the 25th of July at 10:00am hosted by Colin fidock, or Thursday morning the 28th at 11:00 hosted by either Cameron or Don. The series will run through a different topic each week, looking all of the books, characters and events in the bible, fitting them all together to form the Big Story. If you have any friends or family that have showed an interest or have been asking questions lately, this would be a great series to invite them along too. Looking forward to seeing you there.
