**IN OUR CHURCH**

**Psalm 121**

Psalm 121 is one of a number of psalms titled ‘A Song of Ascents’. These psalms were originally sung by pilgrims on their way up to Jerusalem for the major festivals (one always went ‘up’ to Jerusalem, hence the title). Even today a journey, particularly a long journey, can carry an element of risk, but when this psalm was first sung (probably before 600BC) risks to travellers were far greater. The song begins with a question, put by a perhaps anxious pilgrim, *‘I lift up my eyes to the hills — from where will my help come?’* It’s a loaded question! At that time faith in God was being challenged by alternate religions which set up their places of worship in what were called ‘the high places’ – that is on the top of hills. In Psalm 121 the pilgrim faces a suggestive temptation, should she or he follow the cultural trend and turn to the gods of the high places? The remainder of the psalm provides the joyful answer – a response and a joy which has been echoed through the centuries by pilgrims on the journey of life.
