From the Heart: Giving and the Kingdom

There is a moment in 1 Chronicles when King David, once the warrior, now worships before the people. In response to the generosity of the assembly, he lifts a prayer of deep humility:

"Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand."

This simple truth sits at the centre of our faith and our life together: all we have is a gift from God. Our time, our talents, our resources—they are entrusted to us not for our glory, but for God's kingdom.

Jesus echoes this in today's gospel:

"Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Giving isn't really about fundraising. It's about our formation as disciples. It's about how our hearts are shaped, where our values lie, where God reigns in our lives.

At St Luke's, we're not just a congregation—we're a community on mission. Our Mission Action Plan calls us to grow in faith, build deeper relationships, and share the hope of Christ. We don't build this kingdom with money alone. We build it with trust, generosity, and hearts open to God's leading.

In the quiet work of pastoral care, in acts of welcome and courage—we glimpse the kingdom coming near. We see it in lives changed and hearts opened.

So as we reflect this week on giving to build the kingdom, let our giving be a declaration:

"Christ reigns here. And I want to be part of what God is doing."
