If you ask non-believers what they know about Jesus, most of them are likely to remember that he walked on water, and also that he healed people. They probably won't have any idea why he would have done the former. They might suppose it to have been a sort of party trick, or an illusory effect he created in his disciples' minds to build his personal mystique. Strategic thinkers might think Jesus decided to do some remarkable things for the publicity, to attract a bigger personal following.

But neither Jesus's walking on the lake, nor his easier-to-understand healings such as those at Gennesaret in today's gospel reading, or indeed any of his other miracles, were aimed mainly at building mystique or attracting more followers. Jesus's control over the natural world in today's Matthew reading is one of the wonders which reveal the most important thing about Jesus, his identity as God the Son. The disciples seeing Jesus walking on the water were wet and cold and frightened, and they knew they could do nothing to control the sea. Only one person could do that. He had it under his feet, you might say. Healings and other works of mercy did indeed benefit people but, beyond that, they were signs pointing to Jesus's unique identity.
