# Only Believe

Today's readings lead us into the mystery and wonder of transformation. We meet Saul, whose rigid certainty is shattered by a voice from heaven. We stand in awe before the poetic visions of Revelation, where a wounded Lamb holds the power to redeem all things. We gather with Peter at a charcoal fire on the beach, where failure meets forgiveness and shame is met with breakfast and love.

Each of these stories reminds us that the life of faith isn't neat or perfect. It's full of turning points and open-ended questions. The people God uses are rarely polished saints—they are, like us, imperfect and incomplete. Their wounds still show. Their fears still surface. But they are called. And they trust the voice that calls them by name.

In this Easter season, we are invited to remember that resurrection life is not the same as perfection. Jesus rose with wounds still visible. The scars remained. And it was those scars that made him recognisable to those who loved him.

So if you come today carrying questions, doubts, regrets—or even a deep weariness—know that you are not disqualified. You are in good company. The good news is that transformation is possible, even for us. Not all at once. Not without cost. But by grace. And always in love. May our worship today open our hearts to the One who still calls us by name, and help us believe—even when we do not yet understand.

Car Parking. Parish Council has made a decision that the top car park at St Luke's should be designated as 'Easy Access Parking' for use by those with mobility issues or for the loading or unloading of goods. If you don't have mobility difficulties, please park in the lower car park and walk up the path, through the garden, to the church. Please note, we will retain the designated disabled parks for those who have disability parking permits but the remainder of the top carpark will be available for those who have mobility issues or things to unload.

**Defibrillator.** Parish Council has approved a proposal that the Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) should be moved from its current location inside the church foyer to a position outside the front door of the church. This decision has been made after consideration of the possibility of a need for emergency access by the Op Shop and Garden communities and also aligns with current general practice to make AED's readily accessible to the public.
