Everyday Saints!

The Church Calendar is full of days dedicated to remembering people who, through the centuries, have served the Lord Jesus Christ in exemplary ways. In various ways they have enriched and enhanced our understanding of our faith, we can learn from them, and they deserve to be remembered. The shorthand way we refer to these heroes of the faith is to call them 'saints'. Interestingly, however, in the New Testament, all Christians are saints, even imperfect ones like me (and you)! St Paul, for example, opens his first letter to the Corinthians like this:

² To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours. (RSV)

We are 'saints' firstly because we are sanctified (literally 'made holy') in Christ Jesus. In other words, we are forgiven and restored to God through what Jesus has done for us. But we are then called to live out this holiness, day to day - we are called to be everyday saints!
