IN OUR CHURCH

Today's topic is 'Discipleship means a life of self-giving and service'.

If you are anything like me this may seem like a bit of a daunting thought. When I first looked at the heading of today's topic, I thought to myself, this doesn't sound like the most encouraging aspect of discipleship, it certainly would not be my opening line when speaking to someone on the street. The good news is that you are not alone, a lot of the people that Jesus spoke to during his ministry also struggled with the concept of living a self-giving life of service, giving up everything and following Jesus. However, as Christians this is what we are called to do. Being a disciple of Christ means following Jesus in all that we do, in fact Jesus is quoted 87 times throughout the New Testament as saying, 'Follow me'. Sometimes in order to follow in the path of Jesus we need to take a detour from the direction that we were heading, giving ourselves over to God's will and not our own. The heart of Jesus call leads us to live our lives differently, using our God given gifts, talents and abilities to serve God, the church and those around us.
