



"Joyful Noise" Children's Choir provides an affordable and quality music education in a Christian context. This program is offered by St. Luke's Church who seek to build community and share the hope we have in Christ while offering children a fun environment to make friends and learn new skills.

Through choral singing members of Joyful Noise learn to read music and sing in parts. They gain confidence and performance skills and have the opportunity to hear the Gospel message in the context of song. Families and children do not have to be Christian to be part of Joyful Noise, though. We sing both sacred and secular music, in a wide range of styles.

Joyful Noise rehearses from 4.00 - 5.30 pm on Tuesday afternoons at St Luke's during school terms and is open to children in Year 3 and above. St Luke's is at 25 Smart Road, Modbury. Opposite the Modbury Triangle.

In addition to weekly rehearsals, families are expected to commit to:

- Two invitational Sunday Services per year.
- Annual Carols Night
- Two afternoon or evening concerts/year



The Choir Conductor and Teacher is Reverend Jo Smith, Parish Priest and experienced music teacher. Rev. Jo is supported by a professional accompanist, Gregg Eustice and a small group of volunteers from the parish who help with welcoming and supervising the children and getting them snacks. Rev Jo, Gregg and all parish volunteers have Safe Ministry Accreditation. (incorporating training, police checks and working with children checks).

The cost per student is \$100 per term. This covers the cost of music and a professional accompanist, a t-shirt and water bottle, and a small healthy snack at each rehearsal. We wear our t-shirts and bring our water bottles to every rehearsal to show we are proud to be part of the Joyful Noise team. Families unable to afford the fee may apply for whole or partial scholarships.
