IN OUR CHURCH

Today's topic is 'Discipleship means lifelong learning'.

Your inner reactions to that might depend on whether your experiences of learning have thus far been mostly positive or negative. If the former, you might be pleased to hear that being a Christian disciple involves lifelong learning. If it was the latter, you might not want to think about lifelong learning ever being connected with your church!

Some of Jesus's audience in today's gospel wouldn't have connected easily with the idea of the yoke of lifelong learning, either. Jesus puts their minds at rest. He tells them, and us, 'Come to me, all you who are exhausted by your burdens... take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, because I am gentle and humble in heart.' His yoke is described as 'easy', or 'well-fitting'. Literal yokes were designed (when training oxen) to be joined to that of a more experienced animal for learning-on-the job.

By working in partnership with Jesus as we do his work we will grow, individually and collectively, into what we were designed to be.
