As we arrive at the Fourth Sunday of Advent, our journey of waiting reaches its quiet, attentive climax. Over these weeks we have been invited to **watch**, to **prepare**, and to **rejoice**—simple words that have shaped our hope as we move closer to Christmas. Today, the word placed before us is different again: **Behold**.

To behold is to stop, to look carefully, and to take in what is truly before us. It is not a word of haste or action, but of deep attention. And in a week marked by grief, shock, and sorrow—following the violence at Bondi Beach and the painful eruption of hatred, racism, and antisemitism in our country—this call to behold feels especially demanding.

The scriptures today invite us to see both the pain of the world and the presence of God within it. Isaiah speaks of a sign given in fearful times: a child called *Immanuel*, God-with-us. Paul reminds us that God's promises are not sudden or fragile, but long-held and faithful. And Matthew draws us close to Joseph, who, in confusion and fear, is asked not to turn away, but to stay and trust what God is doing.

This Sunday is not about rushing to easy answers or soft comfort. It is about learning how to see clearly—to face the darkness honestly while holding fast to the promise of God's nearness. As Advent draws to a close, we are invited to behold the God who comes not in power or force, but in vulnerability, mercy, and love.

May today's worship help us to see more clearly, to hold one another more closely, and to prepare our hearts to welcome the Christ who comes to dwell among us.
