Colossians 2.6-15: Victory through the cross

As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith . . . See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the universe, and not according to Christ. (Colossians 2.6 - 8)

The Colossian Christians had received Christ – which is to say they had come to put their faith in him. It seems though, that some had remained at that point. They had put their faith in Christ but they had not *grown* in their faith, they were spiritually immature – hence Paul's exhortation in the opening verses of our passage, 'As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, continue to live your lives in him, ⁷ rooted and built up in him and established *in the faith* . . . '(Col 2.6-7)

One of the dangers of a lack of growth in faith is that the spiritually immature are easily captured and led astray by seemingly plausible philosophies or empty 'beliefs' that claim to offer special insight, or fulfilment or salvation (or all three!) but which were not 'according to Christ' (verse 8). These abounded in Paul's time (as they do today) so, to guard his readers against this danger, Paul reinforces the foundations of Christian faith, reminding them of the greatness of Christ (verses 9 and 10) and the greatness of what God has done for us through Christ (verses 11 - 15), concluding with a magnificent statement of the victory of the cross (verses 14 - 15).

Electronic Sign. Parish Council has for some time been concerned about the outdated and worn signage on Smart Road. We believe that it reflects poorly on the life of the church community and misrepresents the real vitality of our mission and daily activities on the site. One strategy of our mission plan to share the hope we have in Jesus is to create more effective signage on Smart Road. An electronic sign with dynamic images and messaging is considered to be the most effective way of representing the vibrancy of our parish life and engaging the local community.

Accordingly, the Modbury and Golden Grove Parish Council meeting on 21st June, 2025, passed the following motion:

That Parish Council provides the Diocesan Property, Finance and Resources Committee with a proposal for the installation of an electronic sign at St Luke's at an approximate cost of \$35k with the project to be funded ultimately from the sale of the Golden Grove site. An electronic sign on Smart Road would show a rolling slide show of images and text highlighting our community garden, op shop, children's choir, foodbank, bible studies, sermon highlights, worship services and other events; and provide information about service times, contact details and how people can become involved. It can be easily updated via a smart phone app. Parishioners are invited to comment or ask questions about this proposal by emailing the office stlukesmodbury@outlook.com before Friday, 8th August.
