#### ADVENT SUNDAY

(Matthew 24:36-44)

Our Gospel reading today forms part of a long response by Jesus to some innocuous remarks by some of his disciples, at the beginning of the chapter about the grandeur of the temple in Jerusalem.

Jesus responds by saying essentially (though using some very dramatic language) that nothing the disciples see before them – and by extension, no earthly structure is permanent nor should be relied on.

What can be relied on, he tells them, in the certainty of his return in glory, and the vital necessity of being ready for that day (Matt 24:44)
