Australia Day and All That

Over the past few years the celebration of Australia Day on 26th January has generated controversy because of the association of that day with colonisation and the consequent suffering of generations of indigenous people. Australian cricket captain Pat Cummins (amongst others) has called for a celebration of Australia Day on a day other than 26th January, suggesting that this may be less wounding to indigenous people. I'm not sure that a change to another day would achieve that (though I'm not opposed to the idea). As with a number of issues in our community at present, so much of the debate around 26th January seems highly emotive and polarized - I'm reminded of a line from Yeats. 'the best lack all conviction, while the worst are full of passionate intensity'. That said, while we continue to strive to address the disadvantage and suffering still being experienced by some indigenous people, I think we must find a way to celebrate, without acrimony and without hubris, the values that have made Australia such a great country.
