Problems in Corinth (1 Corinthians 1.10-18)

The situation St Paul addresses in our New Testament reading is one which, sadly, most church members have experienced at some time in their faith journey. It's the problem of division and conflict within a local congregation. In Corinth the conflict involved disputes between different groups about who had the most spiritual wisdom. Paul is horrified. For him this is evidence that these quarrelling groups have drifted away from the truth of the gospel and drifted into wayward thinking and disputes which contradict their faith and injure their fellowship and mission. There's little doubt that all of this was due in large part to the influence of the surrounding culture. Corinth was a cosmopolitan city in which an ability to demonstrate superior wisdom through sophisticated speech brought social esteem, aggressive self-promotion was taken for granted and boasting, factions, and disputation were the norm. The church was in Corinth but a very negative part of Corinth was in the church. Churches today, ours included, need to be aware of this subtle tendency to import pervasive cultural values into the life of the church. Paul's remedy for the problems at Corinth, and for similar problems in churches today, is to take drifting churches back to the cross of Christ as the foundation for faith and the key to understanding how Christians should relate to one another and to the wider community.
