Sunday 2nd October - Creation Sunday: St Francis, Patron Saint of Ecology

St Francis of Assisi (1181 – 1226) founded a movement which sought to serve God and God's creation unfettered by the distractions and impediments of wealth and status. Through the centuries the Franciscans, in their various orders, have been responsible for immense contributions to human flourishing through their work in Christian mission, education and health services, and their work continues today. Francis himself was known for his deep appreciation of God's work in creation, and his love for animals, and he became known as the patron saint of animals. In November 1979 Pope John Paul II declared Francis to be the patron saint of ecology, adding later that Francis' love and care for creation challenges us "not to behave like dissident predators where nature is concerned, but to assume responsibility for it, taking all care so that everything stays healthy and integrated, so as to offer a welcoming and friendly environment to those who succeed us."
