The Sermon on the Mount

The Sermon on the Mount has been described by scholars as “The Manifesto of the King.” It outlines the kind of life which is expected of members of the “new community” of the kingdom of God. It does not, however, propose a legalistic formula, but rather calls the members of the kingdom to *faith* in every area of life. The sermon, as recorded by Matthew, may incorporate extracts of several messages that Jesus gave, recalled by Matthew under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, to give us today an authentic and coherent presentation of the teachings of Jesus.
