John 11.1 – 45: The death and raining of Lazarus

Suffering and death are a constant challenge to those who believe in the love and faithfulness of God. If you don't believe in God then while you still have to deal with suffering, you don't have to wrestle with why a loving God would allow it to happen. Even in Australia, where we are somewhat insulated from the harshness that characterises life in most parts of the world, suffering and death occasionally shatter the wellbeing that we often take for granted. This is particularly true when people die before their time. The death of a child, a brother or sister, a partner or a dear friend is particularly hard to take. In addition to the gut-wrenching sense of loss that we experience there is also, for Christians, the question of what seems to be a contradiction of God's promised love and faithfulness. We might ask ourselves, 'How could the God who has pledged love to us and to whom, Sunday by Sunday, we pledge our faith, allow this to happen?' While it cannot give us a complete understanding, the account, in John chapter 11, of the death and raising of Lazarus can offer some insights that might help us deal with such questions, and it does so by underlining the greater purpose of God, the deep love of God and the reliability of the promise of God.

Proposed Merger: Special Vestry Meetings

Special Vestry Meetings to decide on the proposed merger between St Luke's and St Mark's will be held on Sunday 16th April at 11am (for St Luke's) and Sunday 23rd April at 11am (for St Mark's).

St Luke's Vestry, since it is the first to meet, will debate the following motion: That this Vestry resolves to amalgamate with the Parish of Golden Grove, that the new parish be named the Parish of Modbury and Golden Grove, and that the Parish Councils of the two parishes be authorised to commence work to this end with Synod Office. If this motion (or an amended version of it) is carried, it will then go to St Mark's Vestry on the following Sunday.

Both Vestry meetings will include opportunity for questions and answers prior to debate on the motion, and an explanatory text will be provided in the weeks before the Vestry meetings. This text will seek to explain the rationale for the proposed merger and, if both Vestries approve it, the steps that will be involved prior to its implementation.
